

- Dieselgate momentum



CRITERIA FOR AN EFFICIENT LEZ

- Large enough coverage
- Use remote sensing data
- Link to ANPR; enforcement for foreign vehicles

• Up to date, easily accessible information


RISK: OLD DIESEL EXPORTS TO CEE COUNTRIES

- 43 million dirty diesel on our roads
- 350,000 polluting 2nd-hand diesels were exported to Poland in 2017
- EU-wide on-road compliance is needed



RELEVANT EU-LEVEL POLICY

- Commission non-binding guidelines on LEZ
- Background legislation: Ambient Air Quality Directives
- Euro 7
- Post-2020 LDV CO2 standards



TAKE AWAYS (1)

Over 250 LEZ in the EU

Scope and ambition levels vary greatly

Most euro 6 bans announced for 2025

Getting information to consumers a challenge


